



HENRY McCLOUD |
DIRECTOR, TRiO PROGRAMS

HENRY McCLOUD began his career at the New Jersey Institute of Technology in 1971 as a counselor. In addition to counseling university students, training groups in self-awareness and career awareness, he designed a counseling program for students enrolled in the Engineering Opportunity Program.

Mr. McCloud was promoted to Director of Financial Aid/Assistant Dean of Students. He worked in this capacity for two years and part of his responsibilities included administering all college scholarships, grants, loans, and college work programs, assisting in the orientation for new students and offering supportive services for undergraduates.

In 1975 Henry McCloud became the Assistant Director of Admissions and he held this position for six years. He managed the processing of freshmen admissions, which included the documenting and coordinating of freshmen course placement activity. Mr. McCloud also coordinated the conditional acceptance program, served as financial aid liaison and conducted high school visits.

From 1981 until 1988 Henry McCloud served as Associate Director of Admissions. He serviced and performed personnel evaluations for the professional and clerical support staff, translated policies into office procedures, carried out recruiting plans, participated in the development of a data processing program for the office and played an active roll in the execution of the admissions programs.

Mr. McCloud served as Associate Director of the Graduate Division for a little more than a year. In 1989 he became Director of the Upward Bound Program and Director of TRiO Programs in 1991. He serves in these capacities at the present time. His responsibilities include directing and supervising staff in the Upward Bound, Upward Bound II and Talent Search, Programs. He writes and secures funding for TRiO programs and hires, trains and supervises all administrative and teaching staff.

Henry McCloud currently serves as Secretary to Board of Directors for the Council for Opportunity in Education (COE). He assisted COE in their proposal writing workshops, conducted computer-training workshops, was a member of their Counseling Strategies faculty and has chaired and served on several COE committees. He has also served and chaired the Affirmative Action Council at NJIT and coached the NJIT cross-country team for several years.
